ORDER:

The Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy, Dehradun is organizing the mandatory Phase-II Mid-Career Training (MCT) programmes for Indian Forest Service officers of 14-16 years of service. Phase-II of the course shall be organized by IGNFA from 20<sup>th</sup> February to 18<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

Pursuant to the nominations finalized in the revised letter of IGNFA quoted above, the State Government's approval is conveyed for the following IFS officers borne on Gujarat cadre to participate in Phase-I of Mid-Career Training (MCT) programme.

1. Smt. Anita Karn, IFS (GJ-RR-1997) [3<sup>rd</sup> Nomination]
2. Shri D.T.Vasavada, IFS (GJ-SFS-2000) [1<sup>st</sup> Nomination]

The permission is granted on the following conditions:

- 1) No exemption from the mandatory training would be given, except under very rare and extraordinary circumstances.
- 2) Officers for whom exemption/postponement is being sought on valid grounds, reference is to be mandatorily made to IGNFA/MoEF stating the reasons of postponement failing which the officer will not be given further opportunity to participate in MCTP.
- 3) Under no circumstances, the family members would be allowed to accompany during the training programme including study visit.

- 4) The participants shall be treated on deputation from the date they hand over their charge of post held by each of them till the dates on which they resume duty on return from training. The deputation period shall be treated as "*on duty*" for which they would be entitled to draw pay and allowances as admissible at the rate at which they would have drawn if they had not been proceeded for the training.
- 5) The officers shall submit course completion certificate to this department and the Pay and Accounts Officer, Gandhinagar without fail.
- 6) The Pay and Accounts Officer, Gandhinagar is requested to record the details of MCT training programme in Service Records of officers who submit their course completion certificate.
- 7) It is certified that the officers would have continued on the posts as per their present postings had they not been deputed for the training.
