Preamble :

As per the provisions of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 permission of the Central Government is required for use of forest land for non forest purpose. The Central Government stipulates certain conditions while according such permission, including Compensatory Afforestation at the cost of the user agency. Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 30-10-2002 in IA no. 566 in WP no. 202 of 1995 directed the Central Government to impose Net Present Value (NPV) for the diversion of forest land and also directed to constitute a body for management of Compensatory Afforestation Funds for afforestation, forest development and conservation. Accordingly, the Central Government had constituted an authority known as Compensatory Afforestation Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) vide order dated 23-04-2004. Hon'ble Supreme Court also directed on 5-05-06 to constitute ad-hoc body of CAMPA. Ad-hoc CAMPA has directed State Governments to transfer all the unspent funds received towards

compensatory afforestation into account of Ad-hoc CAMPA and time to time State government has transferred the funds received towards compensatory afforestation/N.P.V and other money. Recently Hon'ble Supreme Court has ordered dated 10-7-2009 to constitute the committees under State CAMPA and gradually to liquidate Adhoc CAMPA.

RESOLUTION :

In pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 10-7-2009, the guidelines on State Compensatory afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (State CAMPA)(hereinafter referred to as State CAMPA) for the purpose of management of money towards compensatory afforestation, Net Present Value and any other money recoverable in pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's order in regard and in compliance of the conditions stipulated by the Central Government and State Government while according approval under Forest Conservation Act,1980 for non-forestry uses of the forest land, the State Government is pleased to appoint the Governing body of the state CAMPA as under :

The Governing Body shall lay down the broad policy framework for the functioning of State Level CAMPA and review its working from time to time.

- (i) Lay down and/ or approve rules and procedures for the functioning of the body and its Executive Committee, subject to the overarching objectives and core principles of the State CAMPA
- (ii) Monitor the progress of the utilization of funds released by the State CAMPA
- (iii) Approve the Annual Plan of Operation (APO) prepared by the Executive Committee
- (iv) Ensure inter-departmental coordination
- (v) Meet at least once in six months

The powers and functions of the State level Executive Committee shall be as under :-


- (i) Take all steps for giving effect to the State CAMPA and overarching objectives and core principles in accordance with rules and procedure approved by the Steering Committee and the approved APO
- (ii) Prepare the APO of the State for various activities, submit it to the Steering Committee before the end of December for each financial year and obtain the Steering committee's concurrence for release of funds, while giving break-up of the proposal activities and estimated costs
- (iii) Supervise the works being implemented in the State out of the funds released from the State CAMPA
- (iv) Be responsible for proper auditing of both receipt and expenditure of funds
- (v) Develop the code for maintenance of the account at the implementing agency level
- (vi) Submit

- (vii) Prepare Annual Report by end of the June for each financial year.
8. The Head Quarter of three committees shall be at Gandhinagar.
9. The non official members in both these committees will be appointed hereafter.


